The attack comes after Israel and Hamas agreed to a ceasefire that took effect on Sunday.

TULKARM, January 27, 2024 (Wafa) – Two Palestinians in their early 20s were killed and four others were injured when the Israeli occupation forces bombed a vehicle at the entrance to Nour Shams camp, east of Tulkarm, according to the Ministry of Health.

It said that two Palestinians were killed in an Israeli drone strike that targeted a vehicle while it was passing through Nabulus Street at the entrance to the camp, causing it to catch fire.

Two Palestinians have been killed by Israeli forces in the Jenin governorate in the occupied West Bank, bringing the total number of people killed in the area since a major assault began almost two weeks ago to 19.

The Israeli military has expanded its assaults in the occupied West Bank, killing two women – one of which was eight months pregnant, during a raid in the Palestinian territory's Nur Shams refugee camp.

The troops opened fire on a Palestinian family at the camp, killing Sondos Jamal Muhammad Shalabi and critically injuring her husband, the Palestinian Ministry of Health said in a statement on Sunday.

NABLUS, February 13, 2025 (Wafa) – Israeli occupation forces shot and killed a Palestinian young man south of Nablus on Thursday morning.

His body was withheld by the occupation army.

Security sources told Wafa that Issa Riyad Issa Jabali, 28, was killed, a resident of the town of Beita, south of Nablus, who was injured this morning by Israeli occupation forces' bullets, near the occupation camp in Huwara.

With the killing of Jabali, the number of slain people in the West Bank since the beginning of this year has risen to 73 people, including 38 in Jenin, 15 in Tubas, seven in Nablus, eight in Tulkarm, three in Hebron, two in Bethlehem, and one in Jerusalem, including 10 children, three women, and two elderly people.

• Gaza's Health Ministry says a total of seven fatalities – two people newly killed and five bodies recovered – have been recorded in the past day and six wounded people have arrived in hospitals after Israeli attacks.

In a statement, it said a total of two fatalities – one newly killed, one body recovery – were recorded and two wounded people arrived in hospitals during the past 24 hours.

This brought the confirmed number of people killed in Israeli attacks since October 7 to at least 48,348, with 111,761 others wounded, the ministry added.

A number of victims remain under the rubble, while the Government Media Office in Gaza has put the death toll at more than 61,000, saying thousands of people missing under the rubble are now presumed dead.

At least six Palestinian infants have died from hypothermia during a severe cold spell in the Gaza Strip, medical officials said.

Dr Saeed Salah, medical director of the Friends of the Patient Charitable Hospital in Gaza City, said on Tuesday that three newborns – aged between one and two days – died shortly after being admitted. Two more children also succumbed on Tuesday morning, with a sixth death reported in Khan Younis, in southern Gaza.

The Commission and the PPS announced in a joint press release that they were informed by the that Ali Ashour Ali Al-Batsh, 62, from Jabalia, north of the Gaza Strip had died in the Israeli prison of Naqab.

They said that Al-Batsh's death brought the total number of detainees who died due to systematic torture in Israeli imprisonment since the onset of the Israeli aggression to 62, including at least 41

Several Palestinians suffocate from tear gas during Israeli raid south of Nablus

NABLUS, March 9, 2025 (Wafa) - Several Palestinian residents suffocated from tear gas on Sunday evening during an Israeli military raid on the town of Qusra, south of Nablus, according to local sources

Sources reported that Israeli forces stormed the said town from the northern side while firing a heavy barrage of tear gas canisters and sound bombs, leading to the suffocation of several citizens.

The town is subjected to daily, repeated raids by Israeli forces, during which live ammunition, tear gas canisters, and sound bombs are continuously fired.

GAZA, March 9, 2025 (Wafa) – A Palestinian citizen was killed and several others were injured in the early hours of Sunday by Israeli occupation forces' gunfire in the Shujaiya neighborhood, east of Gaza City.

According to medical sources, a Palestinian from Ebeid family was killed and others were wounded when Israeli forces opened fire in the Shujaiya area. The victims were targeted while in the vicinity, resulting in casualties.

Additionally, an Israeli drone fired upon citizens in the Zafarana area, east of the Maghazi refugee camp in the central Gaza Strip, although no casualties were reported.

Although a ceasefire agreement came into effect on January 19 after more than 15 months of brutal Israeli genocide, Israel continues to violate the agreement by targeting civilians in the region almost every day.

Israeli drone kills Palestinian child in Gaza City

The Palestinian news agency, Wafa, reports that an Israeli drone opened fire at Palestinians in the Shujayea neighbourhood of Gaza City, killing a three-year-old child.

The report identified the victim as Amjad Abad.

NABLUS, March 14, 2025 (WAFA) – A Palestinian youth Friday succumbed to critical wounds he sustained earlier this evening in an Israeli army raid on Salem town, east of the occupied West Bank city of Nablus, according to local sources.

They said that the occupation forces barged their way into the town, triggering confrontations.

The gun-toting soldiers fired barrages of live ammunition and tear gas canisters, critically wounding a 21-year-old youth in the head, and they briefly held a minor.

The youth, who was identified as Amer Dawoud Shtayyeh, 21, was rushed to hospital, where he was pronounced dead shortly after.




